

Even when you get used to typing on a mobile device, it's complicated and can be cumbersome.

If you have an Android device, there are a number of other keyboards you can download as apps. Some are free and others cost.

To find the best ones, search for **'best Android keyboards'** and you'll find lots of blogs that outline which ones different people prefer.

Some of the most popular are 'swype' (QR Code 1) and 'swiftkey' (QR Code 2).

Swype allows you to run your finger between letters making a word. Once they get used to it, many people prefer this way of typing.



SwiftKey uses advanced predictive text, which guesses what you're going to type.

It learns the sort of words you type and then guesses what you might be trying to say, as well as what you type.
