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This course can be used in the following ways depending on your approach:

- The cards can be used by tutors as part of a structured course (see the possible routes in the Tutor Toolkit)
- The cards can be used by digital champions (e.g. volunteers or nonteaching staff who want to support a resident with digital literacy). This could either be through drop-in / semi-formal sessions or ad-hoc to respond to learner needs. To this end they are divided into themes associated with the type of activity they support:
 - Using Technology (basics around using technology)
 - Keeping In Touch (social media, VOIP etc)
 - E-Safety
 - Sharing Content (photos / video etc)
 - Taking Part (finance, hobbies and civic participation)
